

COOKIES POLICY

Like many other websites, **www.giseledenis.com** uses cookies. Cookies are small text files that websites automatically save into your browser when you enter a website. We do not use cookies that access the information saved onto your hard unit or that may endanger your computer. Cookies allow a website, amongst other things, to save and retrieve information about the navigation habits of the computer user and, depending on the information in them and the way your computer is being used, they may be used to identify the user.

What kind of cookies does this website use?

- **Own cookies:** These are the cookies that are sent to the user's computer from a domain or computer managed by the editor of the website and from which the requested service is being provided.
- **Third-party cookies:** These are the cookies sent to the user's computer from a domain or computer that is not managed by the editor, but by another entity which will manage the data obtained through the cookies.
- **Session cookies:** These are a type of cookies that have been designed to collect and save data while the user is visiting a website.
- **Persistent cookies:** These are a type of cookies that save data into the user's computer and that may be accessed and managed for a period of time that depends on how they have been set up by the cookies administrator and that may range from just a few minutes to several years.
- **Advertising cookies:** These are the cookies that allow the management of publicity spaces in the most efficient manner, which, in turn, the editor may have entered onto a website, application or platform from which the requested service is being offered according to different criteria such as edited contents or add display frequency. For that purpose, we use cookies to make sure that our users are not exposed to a particularly abusive publicity campaign online.
- **Analysis cookies:** These are cookies that either managed by us or by third parties, allow us to quantify the number of user and therefore to carry out measurements and statistical analysis on the use of our services by our users. For this purpose, we analyse their flow through our website and according to the results obtained, we improve the products and services that we offer. These cookies allow us to determine when a particular user visualised for the last time a warning message to let him know that he/she was entering a geographic area or country in particular.

How to disable or eliminate cookies?

You may block or eliminate the cookies from your computer by configuring your browser options accordingly. The steps to disable or eliminate the cookies from the main browsers are shown below:
